- Massage and tanning (excluding medical massage)
- Swimming pools
- Playgrounds, recreation centers
- Arcades, bowling alleys, movie theatres
- Gyms, fitness centers
- Performance venues
- Indoor play centers
- Social clubs
- Bars
- Food courts
- Any indoor and outdoor venue where social gatherings of ten or more people congregate
- K-12 schools, universities, trade schools in person classes. Schools may use adaptive learing/instruction techniques and food may still be prepared and made available following appropriate health guidelines

RESTRICTED

REQUIRED to exclude employees who are ill and **REQUIRED** to practice 6 feet of physical distancing, prohibit gatherings of 10 people or more in a single confined space

All other businesses and work sites not listed in Closed or Essential

Food service with modifications: Establishments MUST

Prohibit dine in/on site food consumption services

Establishments SHOULD

- encourage remote forms of payment
- Clean payment devices between transactions
- Restrict payment handling employees from food service
- Cease self serve unpackaged food (both hot and cold) availability

ESSENTIAL

REQUIRED to exclude employees with fever, cough, shortness of breath and **REQUIRED** to practice 6 feet of physical distancing AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE

- Grocery stores, pharmacies, convenience stores, truck stops, gas stations
- Automotive and bicycle supply, repair and sales
- Pet supply and veterinary services
- Relief facilities such as Food Pantries and shelter facilities
- Food and Beverage Production
- Healthcare, Social Services, care & assisted living facilities
- Childcare for the children of essential employees (with regard to the 10 person altogether rule for gathering, appropriate distancing and adherence to CDC health guide-lines)
- Insurance & financial service providers
- Hardware and supplies stores
- Critical construction trades
- Mail, shipping and delivery
- Laundromats and dry cleaners
- Legal, accounting, and real estate
- Hotels and motels (with modifications in regards to food service practices and distancing)
- Transportation, utilities, and other essential infrastructure
- Government business, military, National Guard facilities
- Law enforcement, jails, secure treatment centers, correctional facilities
- Any facility used to respond to natural disasters or public health emergencies
